Dear all

I've circulated this to those of you coming on Monday who are involved in the AQ Olympics Coordination work and/or are an organisation with have a relevant public AQ dataset, but not the wider modelling community on our email list.

Attached are two notes to guide our discussion – a summary and comparison document of the various UK AQ public data sources, plus a note on objectives. Please have a read through the tables and consider for yourselves what you think the key points are to understanding the various products and the explanation that we as the technical community would provide when asked to explain and give rationale as to why different products give different answers about current and forecast air quality.
