Thank you very much for clustering the regional technical contributions!  
Randstad would prefer the second suggestion (traffic measures and low emission zones together).

Now the question is; how are we going to coordinate our contributions. I have 2 suggestions:

Option 1: Each cluster 15 minutes ( $4 * 15 = 1$  hour) + 20 minutes Q+A  
We can ask our expert to coordinate for the cluster 'traffic measures' for all regions, as I saw no other experts in the list. But if another region wants to coordinate it is fine for us as well.

Option 2: Each region 4 minutes ( $14 * 4 = 56 =$  almost 1 hour), + 20 minutes Q+A  
This however, could be more challenging for our audience. We want them to fully be aware of the political debate.

How do other clusters prepare/coordinate? Suggestions?

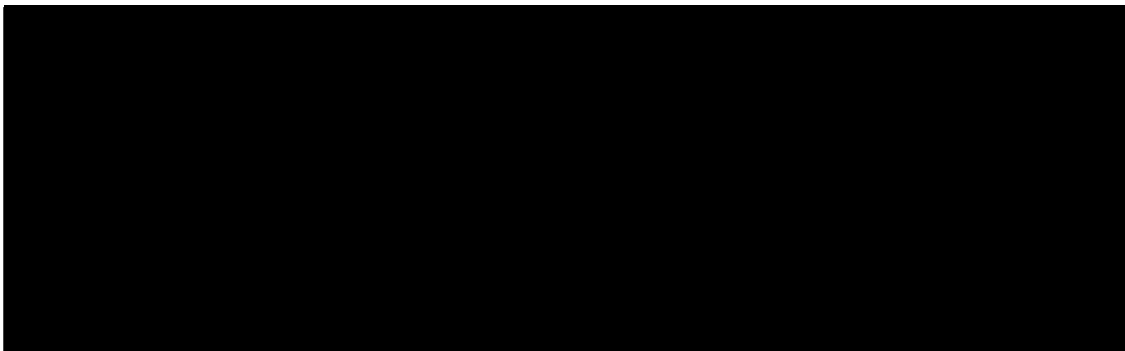

It was very good to meet you yesterday and I am looking forward to working with you on this event. Here, as promised, are my thoughts on how to organise the panel debate in the most effective way possible, in order to make this final part of this conference as dynamic as possible and to ensure an interactive discussion between the political representatives and the Director-General.

I suggest that I launch the debate by giving Karl Falkenberg the floor for 3-4 minutes to outline how he sees the future of EU air quality policy. I would then put a pre-agreed question to each of the political representatives (to be drawn up by me once you let me know what issue they would like to focus on), to which I would ask them to give short (2 minute) replies.

I would then continue the debate by asking both Mr Falkenberg and the political representatives some more questions. Obviously the precise issues we discuss will depend what has been said already, but I propose to draft an email from me, to be sent by you to all the speakers in advance, containing a 'indicative' list of possible themes for our discussion, ideally linked to the content of the memorandum of understanding, so that they can prepare. There would not be time for all of them to answer all of these questions, but I would ensure that everyone replied to at least one of them - and again, given the very short time available for this debate, they would have to limit their replies to about 2 minutes each. This format would hopefully ensure plenty of interaction and debate, which I think is essential both to avoid this last session being little more than a series of statements (and thus very similar to the previous part), to retain the interest of the audience, and to make the most of having Mr Falkenberg with us. If you all agree with this approach, I will wait for you to send me information about what the political representatives would like to focus on in my first question to them, and will then draft an email to them all as outlined above, which I would send to you for comments before it goes out to them. This should ideally be sent out a week before the event.

One last point: as we discussed, I suggest reducing the signing ceremony to just 10 minutes (by getting them all to sign just one piece of paper) and then allowing 5 minutes for photos, which would give us 10 minutes more for the panel discussion - precious minutes if we are to have a good debate!

## **Air-Quality Initiative of Regions (AIR)**

The European Regions of **Baden-Württemberg, Catalunya, Emilia-Romagna, Greater London, Hessen, Lombardia, North Rhine-Westphalia, Piemonte, Randstad, Steiermark, Veneto and Vlaanderen**

### ***RECOGNIZING THAT:***

- Good and clean air is essential to human health;
- The goal of an ambitious air quality policy is to promote clean air;
- Over the past decade air quality has substantially been improved, as a result of regulation at EU level, national efforts and measures at regional level. The EU Air Quality Directive (2008/50/EC, and previous legislation), has been a key policy tool substantially contributing to the improvement of the EU's Air Quality;
- Despite considerable efforts in improving air quality at local and regional level and compliance with most of the targets, there are still problems with some of the standards set by the Directive. This is particularly true for AIR, among the EU's most densely populated, and/or industrialised Regions characterised by special geographic, meteorological and/or structural conditions.

### ***AIR (AIR-QUALITY INITIATIVE OF REGIONS):***

The 12 Regions, from 7 Member States:

- Represent 22% of European GDP with €2,791billions € and 18% of European population with 87,6 million people;
- Invest in research, innovation and infrastructure, take regulatory measures, develop best practices and stimulate behavioural changes aiming to improve air quality and reach the EU Directive's limit values;
- Started working together on air quality issues, since the challenges in meeting the Air Quality Directive's limit values within the specified timeframe created the need to open a dialogue among different European Regions.





**The purpose of this group is to exchange best practices and to contribute to the Air Quality Directive's revision process.**

***AIR EMPHASISES THAT:***

- The revised Directive shall include a degree of flexibility that allows the specific characteristics of our Regions to be taken into account;
- EU shall recognise regional emission reduction measures;
- EU instruments shall further assist Regions in their efforts to improve air quality;
- The EU shall take source-based measures when tackling air quality problems (e.g. Euro standards, realistic test cycles, tyre and brake wear, buildings, industry, clean fuel);
- It is necessary to promote a better integration between EU policies affecting air quality as well as policies at European, national, regional and local level.

***AIR COMMIT TO:***

- Share information about best practices, scientific research results, and possibly take collaborative action;
- Work together on a position paper aiming to contribute to the wide European debate which has started on the Air Quality issues;
- Feed the specific regional perspectives in the Air Quality Directive's review by proactively working with all European Institutions involved in the revision process.
