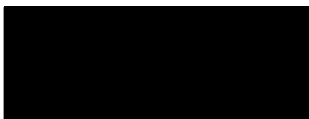

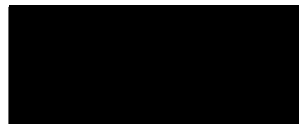

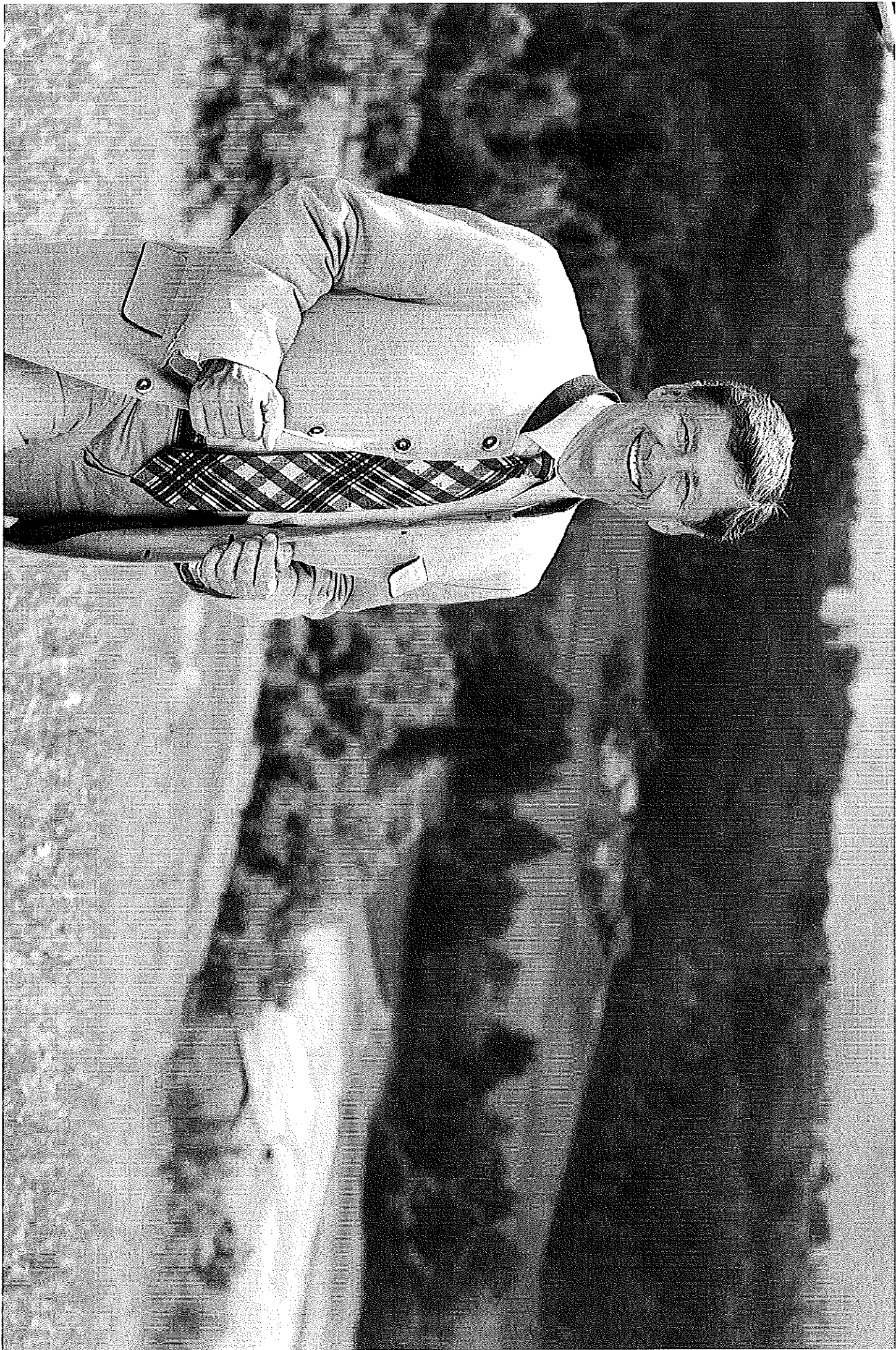

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## Marcello Raimondi

### **Councillor for Environment, Energy and Networks of Lombardy Region**

**Marcello Raimondi**, Councillor for Environment, Energy and Networks of Lombardy Region, has been a member of the regional assembly since 2000. Holding a university degree in Philosophy, he is a journalist by profession and was appointed in the last legislature (2005-2010) Undersecretary to the President of Lombardy Region for Programme Implementation and one of the regional representatives to the Development Agreement and the Lombardy Table responsible for coordinating the events surrounding Expo 2015 in Milan. He is also a member of the Steering and Supervisory Committee of the Programme Agreement with the Chamber of Commerce network toward developing and increasing the competitiveness of the Lombard System, an agreement that includes regional policies to support to companies, research and innovation.

Until July 2008, he was president of the 5th Council Commission "Territory, Infrastructure, Transportation, Building". In this role, Raimondi stood apart as a steadfast promoter of a fact-finding investigation into the regional railway service (the results of which were published in the book *"Il trasporto ferroviario in Lombardia"* part of the series by Irer – Consiglio regionale, 2007). Raimondi also coordinated the inter-commission task force on road safety, which launched a large-scale study on the issue that culminated in a resolution unanimously approved by the Regional Council. He has also played the role of vice president of the 1st "Budget" Committee and the Elections Assembly.

During the 7th Legislature (2000-2005), he was appointed Vice President of the Forza Italia group in the Region, Vice President of the Second Council Commission "Institutional Affairs" and member of the Seventh Commission on "Culture, Professional Training, Trade, Sports, and Information". The regulations he has promoted count among some of the most important measures approved by the Region, including establishment of the "Buono Scuola" (school vouchers) and simplification laws which have cut in half the body of regulations of Lombardy Region.

Raimondi is responsible for the Provincial Catholic Advisory of the PdL of Bergamo and promoter of the "Mi fido di Te" Association. Before devoting his time to politics, Raimondi was a journalist at "L'Eco di Bergamo" newspaper and "Bergamo Tv" and was the director of the Sesaab publishing group. He has also been the driving force behind a number of initiatives in culture and solidarity.

It was very good to meet you yesterday and I am looking forward to working with you on this event. Here, as promised, are my thoughts on how to organise the panel debate in the most effective way possible, in order to make this final part of this conference as dynamic as possible and to ensure an interactive discussion between the political representatives and the Director-General.

I suggest that I launch the debate by giving Karl Falkenberg the floor for 3-4 minutes to outline how he sees the future of EU air quality policy. I would then put a pre-agreed question to each of the political representatives (to be drawn up by me once you let me know what issue they would like to focus on), to which I would ask them to give short (2 minute) replies.

I would then continue the debate by asking both Mr Falkenberg and the political representatives some more questions. Obviously the precise issues we discuss will depend what has been said already, but I propose to draft an email from me, to be sent by you to all the speakers in advance, containing a 'indicative' list of possible themes for our discussion, ideally linked to the content of the memorandum of understanding, so that they can prepare. There would not be time for all of them to answer all of these questions, but I would ensure that everyone replied to at least one of them - and again, given the very short time available for this debate, they would have to limit their replies to about 2 minutes each. This format would hopefully ensure plenty of interaction and debate, which

I think is essential both to avoid this last session being little more than a series of statements (and thus very similar to the previous part), to retain the interest of the audience, and to make the most of having Mr Falkenberg with us.

If you all agree with this approach, I will wait for you to send me information about what the political representatives would like to focus on in my first question to them, and will then draft an email to them all as outlined above, which I would send to you for comments before it goes out to them. This should ideally be sent out a week before the event.

One last point: as we discussed, I suggest reducing the signing ceremony to just 10 minutes (by getting them all to sign just one piece of paper) and then allowing 5 minutes for photos, which would give us 10 minutes more for the panel discussion - precious minutes if we are to have a good debate!

I hope this is a help.
